

THE WORD OF GOD AND THE WORDS OF MUHAMMAD

In Sura 19:19 Muhammad wrote that Jesus Messiah had no sin to declare, but of himself in Sura 40:55 Muhammad wrote that he has many sins to confess. Why is this so?

One of Jesus' followers, the apostle John wrote of Jesus Messiah in 50AD that Jesus was more than just a prophet of God, more than just a man who receives the Word from God to impart to men — he was in the flesh as a man, the very eternal 'Word of God'...

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2He was in the beginning with God. 3All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. 4In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. 5And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. 6There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. 7This man came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all through him might believe. 8He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light. 9That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world. 10He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. 11He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. 12But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: 13who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. 14And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. 15John bore witness of Him and cried out, saying, "This was He of whom I said, 'He who comes after me is preferred before me, for He was before me.'" 16And of His fullness we have all received, and grace for grace. 17For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Messiah.

God's Word is so simple that the pride of man can never receive it, but a little child can. Any answer to any question about God is revealed by God himself by a persistent and repetitive method. God is not silent. God speaks, and just as you or I reveal our inner-selves to others by our words, so God is revealed by his Word. It is as simple as that. The answer to all things is the Word of God! Where did I come from? Why am I here? Who will decide my eternal destiny? All mysteries are made known and hidden treasures revealed with the one same answer. For example; by what means did God separate light from dark? What is the Light of the World? What makes mankind different to the animals? By what means did God create the material universe? *'The Word of God!'* In the material construction of all biological organisms, how and where did the scientific knowledge come from for the complex biotech information code, (DNA) for all living cells to duplicate? DNA is the irrevocable evidence to the existence of God, and reveals God's creation of us and to us and that God 'spoke' into existence all biological life. Consider the electronically stored information on the hard drive of your computer as an evidence of

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your own soul. Your photos, music, your likes and dislikes, your diary, your calendar, your websites, your emails - make up an evidence as to your existence and that you speak and communicate. All this is stored on the inanimate metal hard drive of your computer. DNA as biotech information is the source code of all organic life and is stored on inanimate chemicals in every cell of your material body. What is the testimony of all nature? *The Word of God!* The universe declares the Glory of the Lord. The Word of God or the 'good news' that Jesus Messiah preached, is a very simple message, so simple in fact that the pride of the scientific man can never comprehend it, but a little child can.

The first composite structure of DNA that God called 'Adam' was given a free will by God. In his sinless, perfect domain a Word; as the 'Command' of God gave him the ability to choose good from evil. Adam received a conscience and a free will by simply being dependent on God and obeying the command, *(but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat.'* *Genesis 2:27)* But as we all know too well Adam rebelled and disobeyed the command and offended the Word. God in love restored Adam's dependence upon Himself by giving him another Word called the 'Promise'. This 'promise' requires faith. *(will put enmity between you (Satan) and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed,' He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel."* *Genesis 3.15)* This is the 'Promise of God' to Adam and Eve that the 'Seed of the Woman' would destroy their mutual enemy of sin and death.

The **Law and the Promise** - both are the Word of God, not two words but one Word, not two directions, but one Way, not one condemning us down to the grave while the other tries to pull us up to heaven. Both law and promise are the one same Word that gives Life through the work of the One sinless Man — Jesus Messiah of Nazareth. Law and Promise are one Word as two engines. They have one motivation and one direction with two different functions. The Word of God always was intended to give Life. The Law propels us and orders us forward to God, while the promise draws us and calls us forward to the work of Messiah. The Law reveals our wickedness as sin against a Holy God, and the Promise gives us hope in his love, mercy and grace. Who is the Hope of sinners - none other but the very Word of God Almighty. It is the Law that convicts us of sin and reveals the holiness of God's righteous character to us. It is faith in the Promise that Jesus as the 'Lamb of God' has fulfilled the demand of Law on our behalf, (in that he died in our place). The effect of sin that Adam achieved by disobeying the Word was reversed, and *restored dependant fellowship through faith in the Promise* that God would save his man from sin and death. It's the same for all those born of Adam and Eve. Without conviction by the Word of God, you cannot be saved by the Word of God. God's Law is perfect in

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itself, but offers no hope as it condemns every man, but to be lawless is to be without conviction. So then, to preach forgiveness of sin with no conviction of the Law is not a true representation of God as righteous and just *and loving*. Someone must pay for the sins of the world. Someone must pay the penalty. Put your faith in Jesus Messiah. The Word of God has prevailed! Traditional religion binds people to laws and rituals that cannot save them from their sin and it's end result in eternal death. It denies God and his creature a face to face relationship based on our responsibility as creatures to love and obey the living Word. God alone is independent of everything, we are all dependant on him. Put your faith in the Word of God, the Lord Jesus Messiah and forsake your independence. Who is the Way, the Truth and the Life? The Word of God or God the Word and the Lord Jesus Messiah says, 'I am he!'

The good news is a very simple message. So simple that the religious man can never receive it, but a little child can. A lawyer may perceive that God has made a legal loophole in his perfect justice. In the sinless person of Jesus Messiah as the Word of God who became flesh, the Father God has taken his Word and buried it! The Word that was offended in Adam and Eve's rebellion was sacrificed as the Lamb of God to restore the dependence of man upon the Author of Life. Independence from God is death and a rebellion against the Creator. In the death of the innocent Word of God, that is to say - the Lord Jesus Messiah, the love and the justice of God are upheld, impeccable and fully satisfied. The just penalty and the curse of sin that came through the first man upon all his descendants are fully satisfied in the death of the 'command'. As the Word of God, Jesus is also the 'Curse' on Adam, in the flesh, and this Curse perished, as an accursed thing upon a cross. The love of God to eternally save is fully upheld in the eternally resurrected Promise. All who put their trust in him will never be disappointed. God can save. God loves to love, He loves to forgive but his justice is perfect. Of course everyone wants justice on their enemies, yet at the same time everyone wants love and forgiveness as well. Jesus commands everyone to 'love your enemies' to 'forgive any that persecute you', and says that vengeance belongs to God alone. Messiah's law is the law of absolute love and forgiveness. In that respect Jesus was the last sanctioned 'kill' by God in Scripture. To kill in God's name after this singularly historic event would be a blasphemy against God and the work of Messiah as the Lamb of God, as if the blood of Messiah and the death of God's Word is not sufficient to forgive the sins of the entire world, your enemies included. Here revealed is something of the sins of Muhammad, not to mention the Popes of Roman Catholicism and their successors in the Presidency of the United States of America.

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son*, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. "For God did not send His Son" into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved "He who believes in Him is not condemned, but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son* of God John 3:16

*God has no son in the pagan sense of gods having sexual union with women. This is disgusting. Jesus was born of the Holy Spirit, but as the Word of God he is the 'bosom held Son' in that Almighty God's Word is very dear to Him).

So we see that the good news as the Word of God, is also an ultimatum. You must believe it or you will perish...To understand the ultimatum of the good news, you have to understand God He is who he is and he does not change. God is both perfect love and perfect in justice. If you refuse the perfect love of God to re-establish your dependence on Him through Jesus, then you abide under the perfect justice of God and continue under the condemnation of the law. It is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment Hebrews 9:27 There is no escape from perfect love or perfect justice - that is the Word of God. God has sworn that he takes no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but they die in droves in a continuing flow of DNA propelled life, that ends in a grave. The Word of God is eternal and so there is an eternal responsibility of all mankind to it. The Word of God provides the conscience of a man and a soul that has an eternal outcome in either Heaven or Hell. Don't loose the whole Word, substituting a religious feel-good religion that does not convict us of our sin nor reveal the holiness of our great God. Religiousness is a denial of the personal responsibility of individual man to One God, and God to man. God is able to respond to your words, and his Word has made you able to respond to Him. Put your faith in Jesus the Word of God alone. Between you and God Almighty stands the rebellion of Adam. The Law must slay the old nature, and the Promise must raise up the new man to a new spiritual life in Messiah, a daily walk with God, that is personal and responsible. Jesus said, 'You must be born again.' There is only one Word and one Way to eternal life through death, burial of the old sinful nature, and a resurrection in a new Holy Spirit-filled life.

The good news is a very simple message. So simple that proud man can never receive it, but a little child can. In a person's desire for love and truth he must justify God and not himself or his religion. Man is corrupt, God is perfect and there is no darkness in him at all. Traditional religion is an imposition of superstition and legalism on the simple truth, and as such, is an offence to God. You have to see it through the eyes of God - from his perspective. You have to see it through the eyes of Jesus Messiah, the embodied Word of God, a Word of love that began it all at Creation. You have to see

your life as he saw it, hanging on a Cross for six hours to save sinners from an everlasting burning hell. Around him are the religious mockers, the murderous soldiers, the dying thieves, the weeping apostles, his grieving family and friends. The agony and the sorrow, the love of lost souls, he lifted up, suspended between Heaven and Hell, between the eternal love and the eternal justice of God as the scapegoat of all humanity. You have to see it through his eyes. Six hours hanging between two thieves waiting as one thief slips out of his grasp into everlasting destruction and the other repents and comes to everlasting life.

Do you not even fear God, seeing you are under the same condemnation? "And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong." Then he said to Jesus, "Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom." And Jesus said to him, 'Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise. "Now it was about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour. Then the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was torn in two. And when Jesus had cried out with a loud voice, He said, "Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit. "Having said this, He breathed His last. Luke 23.40

Surely our transgressions and our sins are upon us, and we rot away because of them. How then can we live?' Say to them, As I live, declares the Lord God, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way and live; turn back, turn back from your evil ways, for why will you die...? Ezekiel 33.10.

Yet it pleased the Lord to bruise him, (The Righteous One - Isaiah 53.1) God who takes no pleasure in the death of the wicked, took pleasure in the death of the One sinless, righteous man - the Lord Jesus Messiah because as the Lamb of God, he has taken away the sins of the world. No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him. The relationship of God to his Word is that of a loving Father for a little child. And it is this Word that was committed to the womb of the virgin girl, Mary, two thousand years ago to become the 'forsaken' Word of God, now resurrected, now forever victorious over sin and death.

As the religious people of Messiah's day murdered the simple Truth, so again today, nothing has changed. Still Messiah is betrayed by the simple kiss of a friend, a pope or a prophet - still today the simple good news lies buried under a shroud of religious superstition. Renounce the words of men, believe in the Word of God, put your faith in Jesus Messiah alone - He is the only straight path to God our Father. Get a Bible and pray to your heavenly Father in Jesus name. Repent and be saved.
